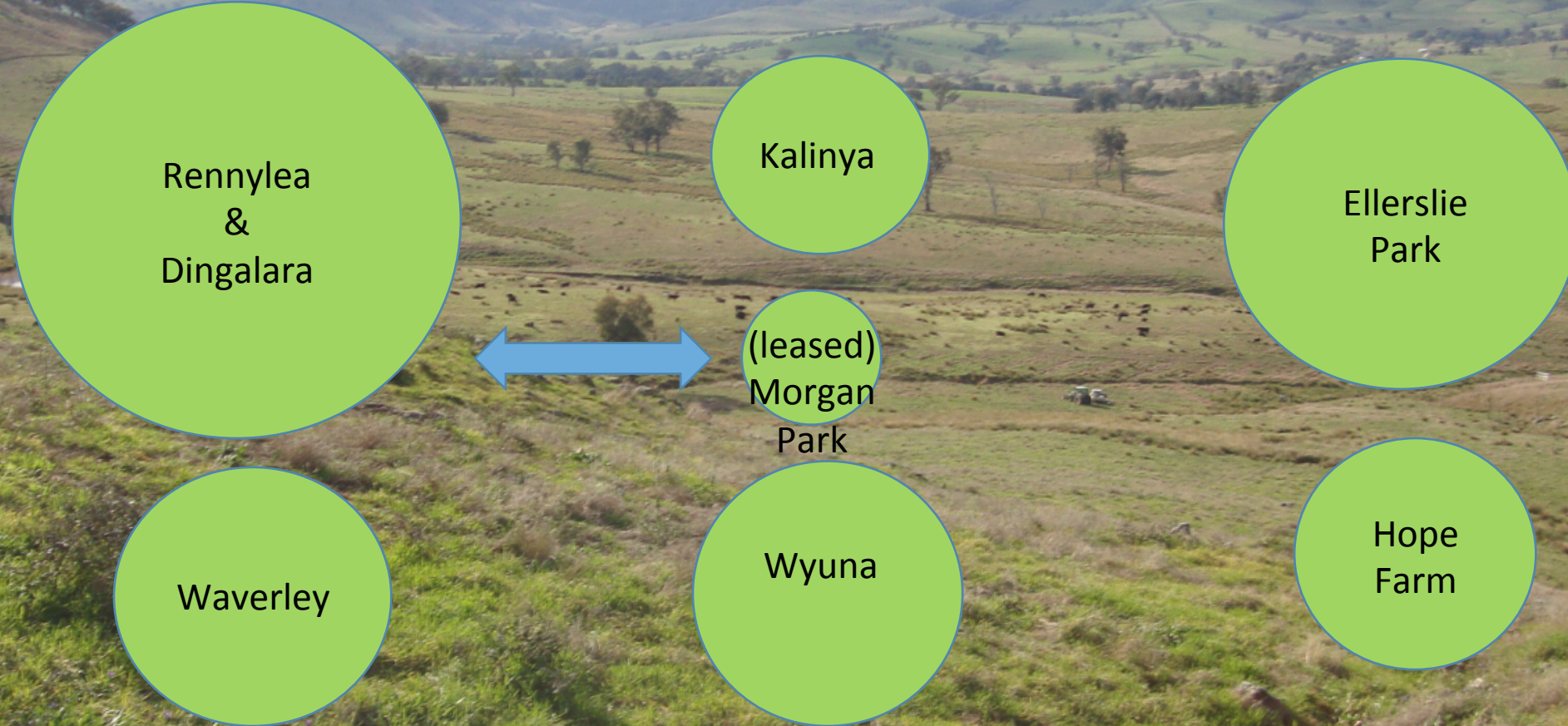

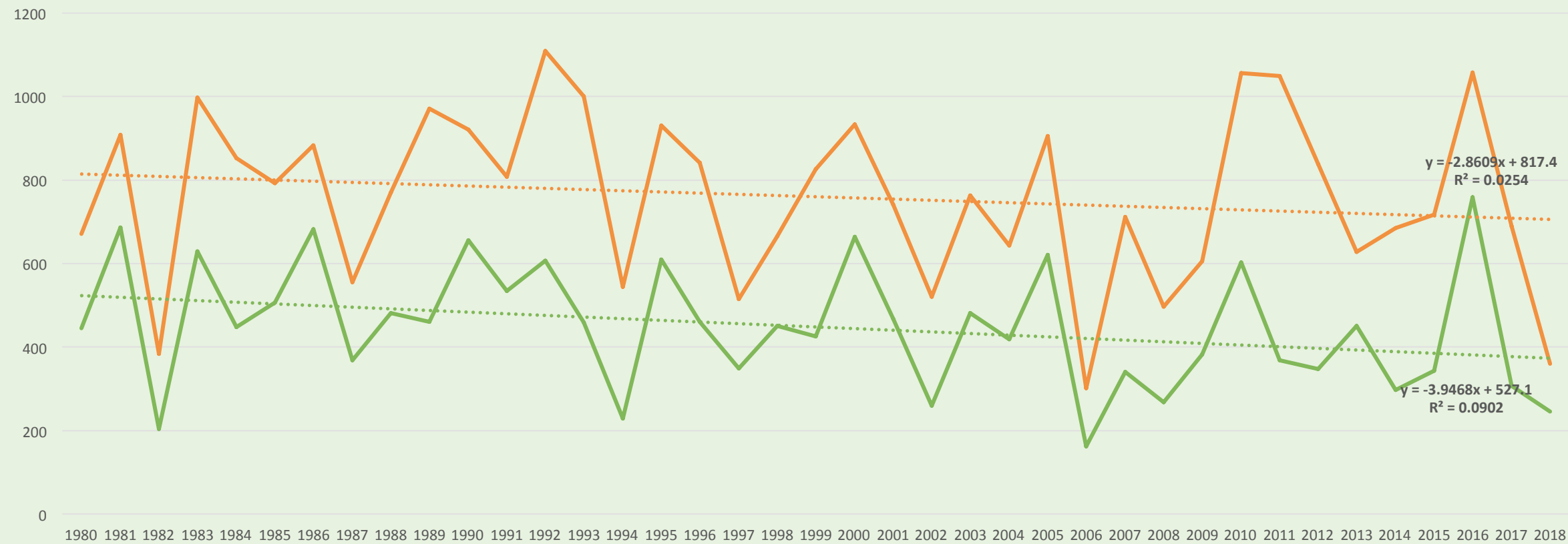

The current and potential contributions of each of these economic sectors are described in the following section, along with a set of recommendations to ensure their ongoing viability.


